PGW agrees with the Hearing
Examiners' recommendation to approve the
Joint Settlement Proposal proffered by the
Company and the Public Advocate with regard
to the 800 Building Renovations.

As the Commission is aware, the project is needed to renovate the first floor of the building, including the conference room, improvements to the lobby and the auditorium, and update the stair towers.

The Joint Settlement Proposal provides that the interdepartmental transfers in the amount of \$4 million should be approved to support the renovations.

The proposed use of the interdepartmental transfers will be in lieu of the conditional funding that was previously approved in the FY '25 Capital Budget and, as the Hearing Examiners' recommendation mentioned, it will be off limits to spending for other purposes.

The proposal is submitted as a

compromise and is proposed to secure the release of immediate funding for the 800 Building Renovations so that the project can proceed on schedule.

PGW is committed to keeping the Commission apprised of construction activities as the project proceeds.
